Renting artwork from local artists is also great for demonstrating support and commitment to the local community. You can even treat the cost of renting artwork as an operating expense, which then reduces taxes.

FAQs

Is there a minimum rental period? The minimum rental period is three months for all artworks. It takes time for artwork to settle into your lifestyle, so this is the perfect time for you to try it out first.

What happens at the end of my rental?

If you decide to make a change, you have options!

- 1) If you've fallen in love with your artwork, you can acquire it depending on the rental program selected below.
- 2) If you'd like to refresh the look of your space, pick something new from my Collection.
- 3) If you'd like to end the rental and return the artwork, please schedule a pickup with me. To schedule a pickup, I kindly request 15 days' notice before your requested pickup date.

Can I purchase the artwork that I am currently leasing?
I am so happy that you've bonded with your painting! If you

decide to acquire the artwork, 15% of the total rental cost will be applied toward the retail price of the painting.

FAQs

Delivery & Installation

There is a one-time fee to cover Delivery and Installation. The fee is \$100 for the first painting and \$50 for each additional painting being installed simultaneously. If the artwork is listed as oversized, there is an additional charge of \$100 plus any applicable out-of-town shipping fees.

How will I be billed?

You will receive an invoice for the entire period of rent.

The first month's rent, delivery, and installation fees are due at the time of the order.

After that, the monthly rent is due at the beginning of each month.

What if I don't like the art I rented?

This is one of the best features of renting! Once living with an artwork, if you decide the piece you rented is not the right one, you can return it after the 3-month rental period and swap it for something else. We have a 3-month rental minimum since it usually takes that long for you to determine if a piece is right for you. Please provide a 15-day notice of your intent to swap your art.

How do I properly handle and care for the art?

There are a few "rules" to handling artwork. First, please avoid touching the surface of any painting or sculpture, as skin oils and acids can cause stains, resulting in permanent damage. Second, never expose an artwork where it will receive direct sunlight or be subject to extremes of temperature and humidity.
